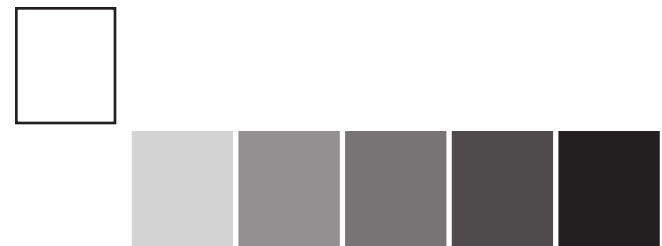

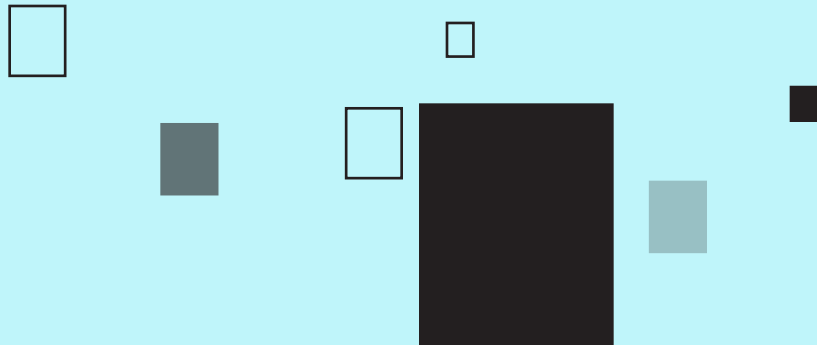


Featuring:
